Deconstruction of the activities

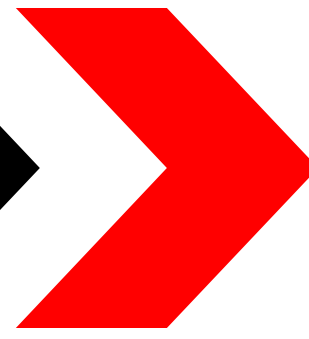
